I too am very pleased that we made it through the summer without major disruptions. As you are well aware, the DPW has been on John Alden Road throughout the summer replacing all the necessary water services. This was a cumbersome undertaking, the first step in this project, and is nearly 100% complete without any issues. As you are also aware, it was our intention to begin the drainage improvements prior to winter shutdown, however, hurricane Irene was able weigh-in on our scheduling of resources, and to this very day we still have crews addressing roadside tree debris and cleanup.

I think overall, Plymouth DPW has “raised the bar” on projects and core services provided to the residents this year. As you look throughout our beautiful Town, you should recognize improvements through reconstruction to Summer Street, Standish Ave, Old Sandwich Road, Atlantic Street, Memorial Drive, Carver Road, the seawall on Long Beach, and the list continues.
